

Regulations for the cycling competition

“Wyścig by Tomasz Marczyński IV edition Skawina 2026”

1. Goal of the competition

- 1.1. Popularization of road cycling in Poland.
- 1.2. Promotion of Skawina, Małopolska, and local tourist and sports attractions.
- 1.3. Identification of the best Participants of the cycling event organized in Skawina on June 21, 2026.
- 1.4. Promotion of a healthy lifestyle, active rest, and recreation.
- 1.5. Promotion of mutual respect between drivers and cyclists: the "Respect" campaign.

2. Event name

„Wyścig by Tomasz Marczyński: IV edition Skawina 2026”

3. Date and place of the event

June 21, 2026, Skawina.

Long distance: 171.3 km / 2657 m elevation, short distance: 86.37 km / 1427 m elevation.*

*The Organizer reserves the right to change the route length due to a change of the start location in Skawina (UMiG Skawina, Rynek 1).

5. Registration

5.1. Registration can be made online from February 22 to June 20, 2026 exclusively through the Organizer's website: www.wyscig.cc. In exceptional cases, the Organizer may consent to registration and payment of the entry fee in cash on the day of the event. The amount of the on-site entry fee is 299 PLN and does not guarantee receiving a full value start package.

5.2. Entry fees:

5.2.1. Until June 20, 2026, until 23:59: 199.00 PLN, with the option to purchase special packages.

5.2.2. Registration on the day of the competition, June 21, 2026, at the Race Office: 299.00 PLN subject to available places.

5.3. All entry fees are gross amounts and include VAT.

5.4. The Organizer reserves the right to close the acceptance of applications and entry fees earlier in the event of the participant limit being reached. The Organizer sets the limit of Participants at 500 people. The Organizer reserves the right to change the limit of Participants.

5.5. VAT invoices for payments made by bank transfer are issued automatically based on the data provided by the applicant. Contact regarding invoice corrections: biuro@s-time.pl.

5.6. The fee once paid is not refundable and not transferable to another Participant. This does not apply to the cancellation of the Competition due to the Organizer.

5.7. The Organizer has prepared a code entitling the first 70 paid Participants of each edition to receive a Velo eBon worth 60 PLN. To receive a Velo eBon, you must register your code on the website ssl.velo.pl (Customer Panel). The registration code will be received from the organizer. Registration codes are valid until November 30, 2026. Each competitor may receive a maximum of one eBon when registering for the event edition organized by the Organizer in 2026.

6. Conditions of Participation

6.1. „Wyścig by Tomasz Marczyński: IV edition Skawina 2026” is a generally accessible cycling event held in open traffic. A Participant of „Wyścig by Tomasz Marczyński” can be a person who meets the following conditions:

6.1.1. Is an adult.

6.1.2. Registers by filling out the application form.

6.1.3. Makes the entry fee payment and is able to present appropriate proof of payment on the day of the Race at the request of the Organizer.

6.1.4. Confirms knowledge and acceptance of the regulations during registration.

6.2. The Race is open to participants using technically efficient bicycles in accordance with applicable regulations.

6.3. The use of full wheels and "baton" type wheels, any type of handlebar extensions (used in time trial bikes, so called lemondki), and wheel axle extensions (known from acrobatics bikes) that may pose a danger to participants moving along the race route is prohibited.

6.4. Starting on electric bicycles, as well as those with mechanical assistance, is prohibited.

6.5. It is strictly forbidden to warm up or ride against traffic on the route during the race under penalty of disqualification.

6.6. The main idea of the Race is building friendly relations on public roads between drivers and cyclists, as well as fair play sports competition.

6.7. Each Participant is obliged to ride in a hard shell helmet.

6.8. By registering, the Participant accepts the clause: „The Organizer, all persons cooperating with them, as well as persons associated with the conduct and organization of the race are not liable to the Participants for personal injury, property damage, and material damage that occurs before, during, or after the race. Participants start at their own risk. Participants bear civil and legal liability for all damage caused by their own fault”.

6.9. Each Participant starts at their own risk and should have third party liability and accident insurance for their own benefit.

6.10. The Organizer reserves the right to allow medical or paramedical personnel employed by or on behalf of the Organizer to provide first aid or perform other medical procedures, as well as transport the injured Participant to a safe place. The Participant agrees to these actions.

6.11. The Participant agrees to the free use of the Participant's image recorded in the form of photographs or video by the Organizer, including making them available to sponsors, official Partners, and Subcontractors. The Participant grants the Personal Data Administrator and the Organizer a non exclusive, unlimited territory and unlimited time license to use the recorded image. This consent applies to the use of the Participant's image for marketing purposes, including in particular for posting and publishing in the press, on websites, broadcasting in television and radio broadcasts, publishing

photos of the Participant from participation in the Competition on social media with the possibility of tagging the Participant by name and surname.

6.12. Each participant must be equipped with a GPS device with a loaded GPX track of the selected distance (GPX tracks to download on the website www.wyscig.cc in the Skawina tab). The route will not be marked.

6.13. The Participant is obliged to use the Strava application and present the route taken if requested by the organizer.

7. Race program

June 21, 2026 (Sunday) *

07:00 - 08:30 Collection of numbers, start packages, and registration at the race office (Urząd Miasta i Gminy Skawina, ul. Rynek 1).

08:45 Opening of the VIP and BASIC start sectors, separately for the long and short distance.

09:09 Start of the first 7-person group of participants on the long distance. Starts in groups of maximum 7 people at time intervals.

10:00 Start of the first 7-person group of participants on the short distance. Starts in groups of maximum 7 people at time intervals.

12:00 - 14:00 Competitions for children

(Park Miejski im Marszałka Józefa Piłsudskiego (starorzecze rzeki Skawinki), Skawina).

15:00 Decoration of children's competitions (plyta Rynku w Skawinie).

17:00 Closure of the race route

17:30 Start of decorations for individual distances and categories, as well as Open categories (plyta Rynku w Skawinie).

**The Organizer reserves the right that the competition schedule may change.*

8. Race

8.1. „Wyścig by Tomasz Marczyński: IV edition Skawina Małopolska 2026” will be held on the routes around Skawina on June 21, 2026 at two distances. Maps of the cycling event will be made available by the Organizer on social media channels and/or the website.

8.2. The race will be held in open traffic. Participants are obliged to comply with the rules of the Road Traffic Code in accordance with the Act of June 20, 1997, Road Traffic Law.

8.3. The start on the long and short distances will take place in a division into 7 person groups, which will start every 5 minutes. The order of applications will determine the assignment to a given group, with the exception of team registrations (see point 12.3).

8.4. The Organizer reserves the right to use a different start method, about which they will inform the Participants at the technical briefing on the day of the event. In the event of a change in the start time of individual distances, the organizer will inform about this fact at least 3 days before the event.

8.5. The travel time will be measured on two sections on the route: „SPRINT SECTION” (start at km 50, finish at km 53 on the short route) and „GPM SECTION” (climb to “Kocierz Spa”: start at km 87, finish at km 90 on the long route). The beginning and end of the section will be marked. The condition for being classified in a given section is completing the entire route within the time limit.

The general time of the entire distance will not be measured.

8.6. The track in GPX format will be made available by the Organizer on social media channels and/or the website. In sudden, unforeseen cases (road damage, road works, etc.), the organizer reserves the right to change the route up to 24 hours before the start time. Participants will be informed about the change on social media channels and/or the website.

8.7. In the event of a participant leaving the route, they must return to it at the place where they left it. If the route is shortened, the Participant will not be classified and will be disqualified in the results of the SPRINT or GPM measuring section depending on the selected distance. There are control points in designated places on the route.

8.8. There will be two nutrition points on the route (49th km on the short route and 90th km and 135th km on the long route).

8.9. The classification of the Participant on the distance will be limited by a time limit. If no other limit is set, the applicable time is 17:00. After the time limit expires, Participants finishing the individual distances may not be included in the final classification of the SECTIONS. In special situations, the organizer reserves the right to postpone the route closing time.

8.10. Participants during the cycling event are obliged to comply with these regulations and treat other Participants of the competition, judges, organizers, security services, and medical services with due respect. Participants are obliged to maintain personal culture (in particular, not to use profanity), comply with fair play rules, and respect the natural environment.

9. Withdrawal of the Participant during the event

9.1. Participants resigning from participating in the event during the Wyścig by Tomasz Marczyński, regardless of the reason for withdrawal, are obliged to immediately inform the organizer and/or medical services, technical services (emergency phone number +48 789 231 877) to avoid initiating a rescue operation.

9.2. In the event that search operations are undertaken as a result of not informing the organizer about withdrawal from the cycling event, all costs of the rescue operation shall be covered by the sought Participant.

9.3. In special cases, with the well being of the Participants in mind, the Organizer, in consultation with the race medical team, has the right to withdraw a Participant from the competition.

10. Benefits for Participants

10.1. As part of the entry fee, the Participant receives:

10.1.1. Start number with an electronic chip and judging service;

10.1.2. Medical security (3 ambulances: one at the start and two points on the route at km);

10.1.3. Support and assistance from the organizer's services in situations requiring it;

10.1.4. The right to use the buffet on the route and at the finish line, as well as a regeneration meal;

10.1.5. A commemorative medal after completing the Race, issued in the competition village;

10.1.6. Prizes and cups, and the right to participate in a prize competition.

11. Age categories

Women:

Open (born 2008 and earlier),
K2: 18:29 years (born 1997:2008),
K3: 30:39 years (born 1987:1996),
K4: 40:49 years (born 1977:1986),
K5: 50 and over (born 1976 and earlier).

Men:

Open (born 2008 and earlier),
M2: 18:29 years (born 1997:2008),
M3: 30:39 years (born 1987:1996),
M4: 40:49 years (born 1977:1986),
M5: 50:59 years (born 1967:1976),
M6A: 60:65 years (born 1961:1966),
M6B: 66 and over (born 1960 and earlier).

12. Prizes and classifications

12.1. During the „Wyścig by Tomasz Marczyński – IV edition Skawina 2026”, the following prizes will be awarded:

- 12.1.1. for the first three places in the OPEN women category on the SPRINT SECTION;
 - 12.1.2. for the first three places in the OPEN women category on the GPM SECTION;
 - 12.1.3. for the first three places in the OPEN men category on the SPRINT SECTION;
 - 12.1.4. for the first three places in the OPEN men category on the GPM SECTION;
 - 12.1.5. for the first three places of each age category on the SPRINT SECTION;
 - 12.1.6. for the first three places of each age category on the GPM SECTION;
 - 12.1.7 for the best team on the GPM SECTION;
 - 12.1.8. During the event, a team classification will be conducted on the GPM SECTION. A team may consist of 4 to 6 Participants of different genders, registered under the same club name, riding in the same group. Registration for the team can be done during the registration of the Participant of the Competition. The same name must be provided without exception. The result is decided by the summary time of the four best Participants of the team at the finish line, including one woman.
- 12.2. Failure to collect the prize by 18:30 results in the inability to collect it later.

13. Road traffic

13.1. The event will take place in open road traffic. All Participants on the route must unconditionally comply with the provisions of the Road Traffic Code and the instructions of the event technical services. Particular caution must be exercised when entering and exiting roads with priority for other road users. Participants are obliged to move on the right side of the road and exercise great caution. Any violation of the provisions of the Road Traffic Code confirmed by the Judges will be punished by disqualification.

13.2. Participants may move in groups not exceeding fifteen people. The distance between the cycling groups cannot be less than 200 meters.

13.3. Participants may not be accompanied by service vehicles on the route.

13.4. The Organizer is not responsible for any collisions and accidents on the route caused by the Participant's fault.

14. Penalties

14.1. The Judging Panel, in consultation with the Organizer, may impose the following penalties:

14.1.1. refusal of admission to the start;

14.1.2. reprimand;

14.1.3. time penalty;

14.1.4. disqualification.

15. Environmental protection

15.1. Participants must respect the natural environment and absolutely cannot litter the race route. All waste, garbage, and packaging should be left only in the so called BUFFET ZONES located at the start and finish of the Race and the nutrition points.

15.2. Littering the race route will be punished in accordance with point 14 of the regulations.

15.3. It is forbidden to use glass containers and other items that pose a threat to the life and health of Participants or fans near and on the route of the competition.

16. Protests

16.1. Protests to the Chief Judge of the event can be submitted in writing during the competition. A deposit of 1000 PLN must be attached to the protest. The deposit will not be returned unless the Chief Judge in consultation with the Organizer grants the person submitting the protest a valid reason. The final decision belongs to the Chief Judge.

17. Personal data administrator

17.1. The administrator of personal data processed in connection with the organization of the event is the company S-Time – Michał Salamon, ul. Flisacka 24b, 34-460 Szczawnica.

17.2. All information regarding the processing of personal data by the Administrator can be found in the Privacy Policy published at the address s-time.pl.

18. Additional information

18.1. The Organizer reserves the right to change the route and/or schedule of the event. The Participant will be notified of this fact by posting relevant information on the Organizer's website. Making changes does not result in any additional obligations on the part of the Organizer towards the Participant.

18.2. The Organizer is not responsible for random accidents that occur while the Participants are traveling to the competition and returning from it.

18.3. The Participant is forbidden from any interference with the appearance of the received start number, in particular removing and covering graphic elements placed on the number, as well as

placing new elements unrelated to the Wyścig by Tomasz Marczyński under penalty of disqualification.

18.4. The Organizer is not financially responsible for items lost during the competition.

18.5. The Organizer is not responsible for any collisions and accidents on the route caused by the Participant's fault.

18.6. The Organizer reserves the right to cancel the event due to natural disasters or other events considered an act of „force majeure”.

18.7. The Organizer and the Chief Judge reserve the right to interpret these regulations and to change them. Lack of knowledge of the regulations will not be accepted as an explanation.

18.8. Anti doping control will take place in accordance with Polish law and anti doping regulations.
